



**Addendum to the JOG Risk Assessment relating to the special risk of the Covid 19 pandemic.**

Date: 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020

Risk	Response
Travel to and from boats	Competitors are advised to use private transport if possible
Crew infection	Competitors exhibiting symptoms, at high risk of infection or in the most vulnerable groups as defined in the Governmental Health guidelines are advised not to take part
On board transmission	Sufficient hand cleansing and disinfecting materials are mandatory. Family groups and two handed crews only are permitted to race Social distancing for non family, double handed crews must be observed in accordance with official guidelines
Involvement of emergency services	Safety boats will be selected from within the racing fleet to render assistance in any non life threatening emergency. One in each class. Wearing of life jackets are compulsory throughout racing and at all times whilst afloat. Non spinnaker classes will be available to all boats to reduce sail handling for the less experienced
Heavy weather	Racing will be cancelled at the Race Officers discretion if forecast or actual winds are 25 knots or above or in the event of heavy seas or unusually adverse factors
General	Any changes in official guidelines will be adopted
