6. The Course

6.1 If the Green Flag is displayed THE COURSE is as follows:

Start line (East to West)

The Needles and all off lying obstructions leave to Port

Finish

6.2 If the **Red Flag** is displayed

The course for all classes will be announced on VHF Channel M1 (37a).

8. Identity Gate.

8.1 Before she starts each yacht (subject to draft) must pass between the beach and one of the Mooring Buoys approximately on the Starting Line in an West to East direction, **showing her sail numbers.**
